Equipment Regulations

1 Sail Number and National Letters

- 1.1 Competitors are reminded that it is requirement of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) that boats racing at international events carry on their mainsail the boat's sail number and national letters in accordance with Appendix G of the RRS and the class rules.

2 Championship Number

- 2.1 Each boat shall, whilst racing, carry on both sides of her mainsail and on the starboard side of the cockpit rear face, the 2017 Championship Number of the competitor sailing the boat (unless agreed otherwise in advance with the race committee), in accordance with the latest ITCA Technical Information published on the ITCA (World) website.
- 2.2 Each boat trolley shall have a tag attached to the handle clearly displaying the same 2017 Championship Number as the boat to which it belongs.

3 Bow Line

- 3.1 A fixed loop shall be formed in the longer end of the bow line (painter) of each boat to facilitate towing.
- 3.2 Competitors are reminded that it is a requirement of the class rules that, whilst racing, their bow line is stowed in a manner which permits its immediate use for towing or mooring.

4 Flight Pennant

- 4.1 Each boat shall, whilst racing, display from the top of her mast a coloured pennant (ribbon) corresponding to her flight colour for that day's racing. (Suitable ribbons will be issued at registration).

5 Event Advertising

- 5.1 If any event sponsor advertising material is issued at registration, competitors shall make every reasonable effort to display it on their boats and sails throughout the event, as directed at registration.

6 Video Cameras

- 6.1 No boat shall have a video camera on board whilst racing without the prior authorisation of the race committee.

7 Electronic Instruments

- 7.1 Competitors are reminded that the class rules prohibit the use of electronic instruments whilst racing, with the exception of electronic timing devices.
