

Measurement Notice No.1

1. All boats will be measured before the start of racing.
2. Measurement will take place at the Rescue Shed from 0930-1300 and 1330-1730 on Saturday 23rd July and on Sunday 24th July and at other times by arrangement.
3. Boats should be presented for measurement fully rigged with all equipment in place and two reefs in the sail (5.3 rig only).
4. S.I. 31.2 specifies one sail is to be used for the event. This will be checked and identified at measurement and will be marked with the event stamp. If a legal practice sail is on the boat at measurement the race sail must be presented at the same time and rolled out for the checking of numbers and insignia and for stamping.
5. After the completion of racing each day boats may be identified by attachment of an orange flag. These boats should report to the measurers on reaching the shore and before de-rigging. The measurer will detach the flag.
6. Other boats may be checked before or after racing at the measurers' discretion.
7. All sailors are reminded of their responsibilities under RRS 78.1 and Class Rule 7.9.
